ORDER DENYING PETITION
TO REOPEN PROCEEDING

Decision No. 87436 dated June 7, 1977 in this proceeding denied the request of Air California to provide service between San Diego and Palm Springs and to tack that service to its existing Route 5 (service between Palm Springs and San Francisco, Oakland, and San Jose).

By its petition filed July 7, 1977 Air California requested that the proceeding be reopened for the receipt of further evidence. That request was opposed by Pacific Southwest Airlines and by Borrego Springs Airline, doing business as SunAire Lines.

The record in Application No. 54954 is stale. A new application should be filed setting forth the current facts which are deemed to justify the granting of the additional route.

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that the Application To Reopen Proceeding To Modify Decision No. 87436, filed in Application No. 54954 by Air California on July 7, 1977, is hereby denied.
