**ORDER EXTENDING STAY OF DECISION NO. 89729  
AND DENYING REHEARING OF DECISION NO. 89878**

Gray Line, Inc. has filed an application for rehearing of Decision No. 89878 which stayed Decision No. 89729 for 60 days from the date of service thereof upon each contemnor. The stay as to Ronald J. Ratti, and Donald L. Fassett, expires on February 13, 1979 and February 16, 1979, respectively. Inasmuch as James D. Kavanaugh has not been personally served with Decision No. 89729, the decision is not effective as to him.

The Commission has considered each and every allegation by Gray Line, Inc. and is of the opinion that rehearing should be denied.

On February 10, 1979 Ronald J. Ratti timely filed a petition for rehearing of Decision No. 89729. In order to allow ample opportunity to consider and review such petition the Commission shall stay Decision No. 89729 as to Mr. Ratti until such time as the Commission otherwise orders.

Donald L. Fassett has not petitioned for rehearing of Decision No. 89729. Instead, on February 7, 1979 Mr. Fassett filed a request to enforce Decision No. 89729 as it pertains to him. The Commission, however, is of the opinion that Decision No. 89729 should be stayed as to each contemnor pending consideration of the petition for rehearing filed by Ronald J. Ratti, notwithstanding the above, so that the Commission may review the merits of the petition as they may relate to each contemnor.

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that the stay of Decision No. 89729 is extended from February 13, 1979 and February 16, 1979 as to Ronald J. Ratti and Donald L. Fassett, respectively, until such time as the Commission otherwise orders.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Executive Director of the Public Utilities Commission cause personal service of this Order on Ronald J. Ratti and Donald L. Fassett.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that rehearing of Decision No. 89798 by Gray Line, Inc. is denied.

The effective date of this order is the date hereof.
