ORDER DISCONTINUING INVESTIGATION


On May 31, 1978 the Commission suspended certain fares filed by Hughes Airwest in its transmittal C-81 and ordered the investigation herein. The fares were suspended because of possible long- and short-haul violations and because certain fares may have resulted in technical increases for which respondent had not received prior Commission approval.

Subsequently respondent filed a revised tariff which removed the possible long- and short-haul violations and obtained authorization for the fare increases in its application, SPT A.58298. The tariff filings involved in this investigation have been superseded by the subsequent filings, and the matter has become moot.

IT IS ORDERED that the tariff filings in Hughes Airwest Revision Transmittal C-81 are canceled and that proceedings in this investigation are discontinued.

The effective date of this order is the date hereof.


