ORDER GRANTING LIMITED REHEARING OF DECISION NO. ~~89729~~ ⁸⁹⁷²⁹ *thd*

Ronald J. Ratti has filed an application for rehearing of Decision No. 89729. Decision No. 89729 is a consolidation of four separate orders. The Commission is of the opinion that rehearing of the orders in Decision No. 89729 denying Ronald J. Ratti's application for a passenger stage certificate, of the order to cease and desist from current operation, and of the order revoking the charter party permit of Mr. Ratti should be denied. However, the Commission is of the opinion that the order to show cause in re


contempt and the contempt order issued in Decision No. 89729 against Ronald J. Ratti and Donald L. Fassett are defective and should be rescinded. The Commission will consider whether the issuance of a new order to show cause in re contempt of Decision No. 89729 against Ronald J. Ratti and Donald L. Fassett is warranted. Therefore,


IT IS ORDERED that rehearing of Decision No. 89729 with respect to the denial of the passenger stage application by Ronald J. Ratti and Donald L. Fassett, the issuance of a cease and desist order against Ronald J. Ratti and Donald L. Fassett, and the revocation of the charter party permit of Ronald J. Ratti is denied.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the order to show cause in re contempt and the contempt order issued in Decision No. 89729 against Ronald J. Ratti and Donald L. Fassett are defective and are therefore rescinded. The Commission will consider whether the issuance of a new order to show cause in re contempt of Decision No. 89729 against Ronald J. Ratti and Donald L. Fassett is warranted.


