ORDER GRANTING A PARTIAL
STAY OF DECISION NO. 90000
AND 30 DAY EXTENSION OF TIME

San Gabriel Valley Water Company (San Gabriel) has filed a Petition for Rehearing of Decision No. 90000 in this proceeding. San Gabriel asks also that Decision No. 90000 be stayed pending review. Pacific Power and Light Company has filed a request for a 30 day extension of time in which to comply with ordering paragraph 1 of Decision No. 90000. San Gabriel's petition for rehearing is now under consideration and will be dealt with on its merits in a subsequent order. However, we are of the opinion that good cause exists for granting San Gabriel a stay of Ordering Paragraph No. 1 of Decision No. 90000 during a period of consideration of the issues raised in its petition for rehearing, and for granting PP&L's request for 30 day extension of time, therefore

IT IS ORDERED that, as to San Gabriel Valley Water Company, Ordering Paragraph No. 1 of Decision No. 90000 is hereby stayed until further order of this Commission.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Pacific Power and Light Company is granted an extension of time to and including April 18, 1979 in which to comply with Ordering Paragraph No. 1 of Decision No. 90000.
