## OPINION AND ORDER

Minimum Rate Tariff 17-A (MRT 17-A) names minimum rates for the transportation of asphaltic concrete, rock, sand, gravel, slag and decomposed granite by highway carriers in dump truck equipment. These rates include area-to-point rates in Section 3 which apply from defined production areas to specified delivery points for the transportation of rock, sand and gravel. Such rates are three cents per ton less than the otherwise applicable zone rates.

By this petition, Huntmix, Inc. requests that its plant located at 1380 Arrow Highway, Irwindale, be designated as a delivery point for shipments of rock products subject to the lower MRT 17-A area-to-point rates. Petitioner also seeks to modify the List of Delivery Points in MRT 17-A by inserting its name for that of Griffith Company at 1601 Alameda Street, Wilmington as they have acquired this plant site from Griffith Company.

Petitioner declares, in its petition, that the facilities at its Irwindale plant are comparable to the facilities of other delivery points listed in Section 3 of MRT 17-A: that the plant meets the criteria previously established as a basis for area-to-point rates by Decision 57675 of December 2, 1958 in Case 5437 and reaffirmed in many later decisions by the Commission.

A staff field survey has determined that the petitioner's plants conform to the delivery criteria established by Decision 57675. The staff investigation discloses that the Irwindale facilities are located in Delivery Zone 19348 and not in Delivery Zone 19337 as stated in the petition.

Copies of the petition were served on various known carriers and shipper organizations and other parties on or about February 6, 1979. The petition was listed on the Commission's Daily Calendar of February 16, 1979. No objection to the granting of the petition has been received.

In the circumstances, the Commission finds that the establishment of an additional delivery point as hereinafter provided will result in just, reasonable and nondiscriminatory minimum rates for the transportation involved. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that the petition should be granted as indicated in the ensuing order.

## IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. Minimum Rate Tariff 17-A (Appendix C of Decision 80578, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein to become effective thirty-nine days after the date hereof, Fifth Revised Page 3-3 and Fifth Revised Page 3-4, attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.
- 2. Common carriers subject to the Public Utilities Act to the extent that they are subject to Decision 80578, as amended, are authorized to establish in their tariffs the amendments necessary to conform with the further adjustments ordered herein.
- 3. Tariff publications authorized to be made by common carriers as a result of this order may be made effective not earlier than thirty-nine days after the date hereof and may be made effective on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public if filed not later than sixty days after the effective date of the minimum rate tariff pages incorporated in this order.

- 4. Common carriers in establishing and maintaining the amendments authorized hereinabove, are hereby authorized to depart from the provisions of Section 461.5 of the Public Utilities Code to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the amendments published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing long- and short-haul departures and to this order.
- 5. In all other respects Decision 80578, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.
- 6. The Executive Director shall serve a copy of this decision on every common carrier, or such carriers' authorized tariff publishing agents, performing transportation services subject to Minimum Rate Tariff 17-A.
- 7. The Executive Director shall serve a copy of each of the tariff amendments on each subscriber to Minimum Rate Tariff 17-A.

The effective date of this order shall be thirty days after the date hereof.
