ORDER DISCONTINUING PROCEEDING

Interim Decision 86073 of July 7, 1976, authorized Ernest John Hofer to deviate from the provisions of Minimum Rate Tariff 2 by assessing a rate of 29 cents per 100 pounds, minimum weight 40,000 pounds, for the transportation of scrap or waste paper for Container Corporation of America between San Diego and various points in the Los Angeles area.

The Commission, in its order, granted applicant temporary authority to deviate from the minimum rates pending hearing on this matter. No public hearing was held and applicant did not prosecute this application to a final conclusion.

In the circumstances, the Commission finds that the authority granted by Decision 86073 should be revoked. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that the proceeding in Application 56202 should be discontinued.

IT IS ORDERED that the minimum rate deviation authority granted by Decision 86073 is revoked and the proceeding in Application 56202 is discontinued.
