OPINION AND ORDER

By this application, Alcal Delivery, Inc., a corporation, requests authority to deviate from the provisions of Minimum Rate Tariffs 1-B, 2, 4-B and 19 (MRT 1-B, 2, 4-B and 19) in connection with the transportation of copying, reproduction, telecommunication and computer machines and their components or related parts, accessories, materials or supplies for the account of Xerox Corporation (Xerox).

The applicant requests a deviation from the above minimum rate tariff rates and rules and wishes to assess rates and prescribe rules which are particularly designed for the specialized transportation required by Xerox. The proposed rates and rules are similar to those previously granted to Data Transportation Co., Inc. (A. 57433 renewed by SDD-826 - September 19, 1978.)

Rates are established on a "per unit" basis and are set at a level designed to produce equal or greater revenues than those generated under MRTs 1-B, 2 and 19. The pricing on a per unit basis follows Xerox's method of cost pricing for transportation in other regions of the United States. The rate increases are within the President's wage-price guidelines.

Based on the special circumstances and conditions as detailed in the application, the applicant's proposed deviation is reasonable.

Revenue and expense data submitted by applicant indicate that the transportation involved may reasonably be expected to be profitable under the proposed rates.

The application and amendment were listed on the Commission's Daily Calendars of January 30, 1979 and March 22, 1979. No objection to the granting of the application has been received.

In the circumstances, the Commission finds that applicant's proposal is reasonable. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that the application, as amended, should be granted to the extent set forth in the ensuing order and the effective date of this order should be the date hereof because there is an immediate need for this rate relief.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Alcal Delivery, Inc., a corporation, is authorized to perform the transportation shown in Appendix A, attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof at not less than the rates set forth therein.

2. The authority granted herein shall expire one year after the effective date of this order unless sooner cancelled, modified or extended by further order of the Commission.

The effective date of this order is the date hereof.

APPENDIX A

CARRIER: ALCAL DELIVERY, INC.

SHIPPER: XEROX CORPORATION

COMMODITIES: Copying, reproduction, telecommunications and computer machines and their component or related parts, accessories, materials or supplies, when moving in connection therewith.

RATES: Schedule 1 - Rates for Transportation within or between Metropolitan Zones 101 through 104 and 108 through 120.

Schedule 2 - Charges for Accessorial or Additional Services.

CONDITIONS:

1. Rates herein apply for service performed during regular working hours of 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., except Saturdays, Sundays, and the following holidays: New Year's Day, Washington's Birthday, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day; and December 24th and 26th, where so observed as holidays. When such holidays fall on Sunday, the following Monday shall be considered a holiday. Except as otherwise provided, for services performed at the request of the shipper or consignee at other than those hours and on Saturdays, Sundays or the holidays shown, additional charges for overtime will be assessed as indicated herein.
2. Shipments will be received and transported under the Straight Bill of Lading-Short Form-Freight Bill provided by Xerox Corporation.
3. Shipments transported under the terms and conditions herein are released to a value not exceeding fifty cents (\$0.50) per pound, per article.
4. References to Metropolitan Zones (MZ's) are those zones as described in the Commission's Distance Table 8 and subsequent revisions or reissues thereto.
5. Applicant has not indicated that subhaulers will be used nor have any costs of subhaulers been submitted. Therefore, if subhaulers are employed, they shall be paid not less than the rates authorized herein without any deduction for use of applicant's trailing equipment.

- Note 5: Charges do not apply to the following machine accessories (manufacturer's identification numbers): 188, 191, 192, 200, 223, 232, 255, 260, 276, 311, 315, 366, 367, 368, 369, 389, 418, 423, 496, 498, 548, 549, 555, 565, 567, 576, 594, 596, 598, 736 and 756 when such accessories are physically attached to a machine.
- Note 6: Premove service includes the preparation of machines for pick-up and subsequent transportation; including draining of fluids, removal and packaging of components, and completion of internal tie-downs, when required and so directed by the shipper.
- Note 7: Unloading service includes unloading from the Contran trailer and performance of required pencil tracings.
- Note 8: Loading service includes loading of the Contran trailer and performance of required pencil tracings.

SCHEDULE 2

CHARGES FOR ACCESSORIAL OR ADDITIONAL SERVICES

Stair Carry:

\$28.50 for each use of Stairmobile plus the hourly charges shown below, as applicable:

Accessorial Service:

Includes upending, special rigging, stair carry, long carry, tracking, removal of furniture or fixtures and other accessorial services required and performed in connection with the movement.

Expedited Service:

Between points within Metropolitan Zones 101 through 104, or 108 through 120:

When "Same Day" pick-up or delivery service is required by the shipper and performed by the carrier, the applicable charges shall be in an amount equal to twice the amounts applicable to shipments within the zones.

Service to Points or Between Points Outside of Zones 101-104 or 108-120

When pick-up or delivery service is required by the shipper and performed by the carrier between a point within Metropolitan Zones 101 through 104 or Zones 108 through 120 and a point outside the aforesaid zones, or between various points in the state outside of the aforesaid zones, the rates shall be construed according to the provisions of Minimum Rate Tariff 2. On such movements, for distances up to 150 miles, the minimum

weight applied to each shipment shall be 3,000 pounds. For distances over 150 miles but not over 250 miles, the minimum weight applied to each shipment shall be 4,000 pounds. For distances over 250 miles, the minimum weight applied to each shipment shall be 5,000 pounds.

Saturday, Sunday, Holiday or Overtime Service

Charges for service performed other than during regular working hours or on Saturdays, Sundays or Holidays will be as follows:
