## SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Decision 90223 dated April 24, 1979 provided an increase of 4.7 percent in rates contained in Minimum Rate Tariff 14-A which governs the transportation of agricultural commodities. The new rates are to be effective June 2, 1979.

It has come to the Commission's attention that the harvest is about to start. It is to both the shipper's and the carrier's advantage to have, as nearly as possible, the same rates in effect for the entire harvest in order to plan with certainty the orderly marketing of this harvest.

In the circumstances, the Commission concludes that the effective date of the tariff pages authorized by Decision 90223 should be advanced from June 2, 1979 to May 19, 1979.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Minimum Rate Tariff 14-A (Appendix A to Decision No. 67397, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein to become effective May 19, 1979, Supplement No. 18, attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

2. Tariff publications of common carriers shall be made effective not earlier than May 19, 1979, on one day's notice to the Commission and to the public.

3. In all other respects, Decision 90223, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

4. The Executive Director shall serve a copy of this decision on every common carrier, or such carriers' authorized tariff publishing agents, performing transportation services subject to Minimum Rate Tariff 14-A.

5. The Executive Director shall serve a copy of the tariff amendment on each subscriber to Minimum Rate Tariff 14-A.
