ORDER REOPENING
PROCEEDING

By an Order filed on May 16, 1979 the California Supreme Court annulled Decision No. 87587 and ordered the Commission to "... determine an appropriate method to spread the rate increase to which the utility is entitled," and to "... order refunds and surcharges, if appropriate ..." Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED, that this proceeding is hereby reopened. Further hearing will be held before such Commissioner or Administrative Law Judge and at such place and time as may hereafter be designated.

The Executive Director is directed to cause appropriate notice of hearing to be mailed at least ten (10) days before such hearing.
