## ORDER MODIFYING DECISION NO. 90155 AND DENYING REHEARING

Gray Line Tours Company has filed a petition for rehearing of Decision No. 90155. The Commission has considered each and every allegation contained therein and is of the opinion that the decision should be modified, but rehearing denied.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Finding 9 of Decision No. 90155 is modified as follows:

"It can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment."

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that rehearing of Decision No. 90155 as herein modified is denied.
