ORDER GRANTING LIMITED REHEARING
OF DECISION NO. 90105

The Cities of Los Angeles and San Diego have filed a joint petition for rehearing of Decision No. 90105 and Southern California Gas Company (SoCal) has filed a response thereto. We have carefully considered each and every allegation of error in that petition and are of the opinion that good cause exists for granting rehearing limited to the question of the appropriate ratemaking treatment of SoCal's short term debt. Therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that rehearing of Decision No. 90105 is granted limited to the receipt of evidence and briefs on the question of the appropriate ratemaking treatment of SoCal's short term debt.

Said rehearing to be held before such Commissioner or Administrative Law Judge and at such time and place as shall hereafter be designated.

The Executive Director is directed to cause appropriate notice of the rehearing to be mailed at least ten (10) days prior to such rehearing.
