ORDER GRANTING PARTIAL STAY OF
DECISION NO. 90316

Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) has filed a petition for rehearing of Decision No. 90316 and for an immediate stay of that decision until this Commission completes action on that petition for rehearing and the decision is no longer subject to judicial review.

PG&E's petition for rehearing is now under consideration and will be dealt with on its merits in a subsequent order. However, we are of the opinion that good cause exists for granting a partial stay of Decision No. 90316, applicable only to PG&E, during the period of our consideration of the issues raised in PG&E's petition for rehearing. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that ordering paragraphs 1 and 5 of Decision No. 90316 are hereby stayed as to PG&E until further order of this Commission.
