ORDER CORRECTING DECISION NO. 90495

California Cities Water Company requested an order authorizing an increase of water rates in its Clearlake District. Decision No. 90495, in Application No. 57969, authorized certain increases. The decision authorized the company to file revised rate schedules as indicated in Appendix A of said decision.

Through inadvertance the rate schedules for Private Fire Protection Service and Public Fire Hydrant Service were omitted from Appendix A. The Commission staff, in its review of the omission, discovered an error in the computation of the rate schedules for annual metered service. The staff had overlooked \$1,800 in revenues from public and private fire protection and from miscellaneous revenues. This error should be corrected by appropriately decreasing the incorrect current rates for general metered service in 1979 and 1980. The reduction in revenues was applied to the two quantity blocks for usage over 200 cubic feet.

In order to rectify the error in Decision No. 90495 at the earliest time, the following order should be effective on the date of signature.

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IT IS ORDERED that the original page of Appendix A be designated as Page 1 of 3, and that the attached Pages 2 of 3, and 3 of 3, of Appendix A be inserted in Decision No. 90495.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that after the effective date of this order, California Cities Water Company is authorized and directed to file the revised rate schedules attached to this order as Appendix A, Page 1 of 3, and Appendix B. Such filing shall comply with General Order No. 96-A. The effective date of the revised schedules shall be the date of filing. The revised schedules shall apply only to service rendered on and after the effective date thereof.

In all other respects Decision No. 90495 shall remain in full force and effect.

PRIVATE FIRE PROTECTION SERVICE

APPLICABILITY

Applicable to all water service furnished to privately owned fire protection systems.

TERRITORY

- Rate A Applicable within the Bay, Big Bear, Central Basin, Cowan Heights, (T) Los Osos, Orange County, Pomona Valley, San Bernardino Valley, San Dimas, Sau Gabriel Valley, Santa Maria, Southwest and Wright-(T) wood Districts, Clearlake.
- Rate B Applicable within the Barstow, Culver City and Simi Valley Districts.
- Rate C Applicable within the Arden-Cordova, Calipatria-Niland, Desert and Ojai Districts.

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For each inch of diameter of service connection	\$3.00	\$2.25	\$2.00

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

1. The fire protection service connection shall be installed by the utility and the cost paid by the applicant. Such payment shall not be subject to refund. The facilities paid for by the applicant shall be the sole property of the applicant.

2. The minimum diameter for fire protection service shall be four inches, and the maximum diameter shall be not more than the diameter of the main to which the service is connected.

3. If a distribution main of adequate size to serve a private fire protection system in addition to all other normal service does not exist in the street or alley adjacent to the premises to be served, then a service main from the nearest existing main of adequate capacity shall be installed by the utility and the cost paid by the applicant. Such payment shall not be subject to refund.

4. Service hereunder is for private fire protection systems to which no connections for other than fire protection purposes are allowed and which are regularly inspected by the underwriters having jurisdiction, are installed according to specifications of the utility, and are maintained to the satisfaction of the utility. The utility may install the standard detector type meter approved by the Board of Fire Underwriters for protection against theft, leakage or waste of water and the cost paid by the applicant. Such payment shall not be subject to refund.

5. In accordance with Section 774 of the Public Utilities Code, the utility is not liable for injury, damage or loss resulting from failure to provide adequate water supply or pressure.

PUBLIC FIRE HYDRANT SERVICE

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APPLICABILITY

Applicable to all fire hydrant service furnished to municipalities, organized fire districts and other political subdivisions of the State.

TERRITORY

Within the established Clearlake District.

RATES	Per Month

For each hydrant §2.00

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

1. Water delivered for purposes other than fire protection shall be charged for at the quantity rates in the appropriate metered service schedule.

2. The cost of relocation of any hydrant shall be paid by the party requesting relocation.

3. Hydrants shall be connected to the utility's system upon the receipt of written request from a public authority. The written request shall designate the specific location of each hydrant and, where appropriate, the ownership, type and size.

4. The utility undertakes to supply only such water at such pressure as may be available at any time through the normal operation of its system.
