ORDER RESCINDING DECISION 89791

By Decision 89791, dated December 19, 1978 in Application 58133, Wendell Preston Bishop and Patricia Ruth Bishop, dba Penmar Transit Company (Penmar), was granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a Passenger stage corporation (PSC 1062) between the San Diego International Airport, San Diego, and the Camp Joseph H. Pendleton Marine Corps Base, located at Oceanside, California.

On January 8, 1979, Penmar was requested by staff of the Los Angeles Passenger Operations Branch to comply with the requirements as set forth in Ordering Paragraph 4(a) through (e) of Decision 89791, specifically to submit a written acceptance of the certificate granted, file tariffs, and timetables and provide the Commission with a Certificate of Insurance as prescribed by General Order No. 101-C. Penmar did not reply to the above communication and was again advised on January 8, 1979 by letter, return receipt requested, that failure to respond to service regulations as outlined in Decision No. 89791 could possibly lead to the Commission's revocation of Penmar's operative rights.

This correspondence was forwarded to the last known address of record of Penmar and returned by the post office on March 29, 1979, marked "Unclaimed".

A thorough search of records indicate that Penmar never submitted insurance documents showing adequate protection against liability imposed by law for payment of damage for personal injury or property damage, as required by General Order No. 101-C.

It appears and the Commission finds that these matters constitute good cause for Rescinding Decision 89791.

IT IS ORDERED that:

Decision 89791 is rescinded.
