On May 3, 1979, one day after notice of the filing of the application appeared on the Commission's Daily Calendar, applicant's attorney filed a motion to dismiss the application. This action was based on plenary jurisdiction over the matter by the Interstate Commerce Commission under Section 5(2)(a)(i), File No. MC F23933F, and Section 214 of the Interstate Commerce Act.

The Revenue Requirements Division and the Legal Division have reviewed the application and the Order for Dismissal and concur that the Commission's jurisdiction over the instant application is preempted by the Interstate Commerce Commission and have no objection to the dismissal of the application.

At such time as the Interstate Commerce Commission issues its order approving the control of Gray Line Scenic Tours; Inc. (Scenic) doa Airport Charter Ines, Inc. and Califormia-Nevada Golden Tours by Peerless Stages, Inc., the Applicant shall file a copy of the order approving the transfer so that this Commission's records will reflect the true ownership of the underlying certificates currently owned by Scenic.

IT IS ORDERED that Application NO. 58836 is hereby dismissed.
