ORDER DISMISSING PETITIONS FOR REHEARING

Southern California Rapid Transit District ("SCRTD"), a protestant in this matter, filed a petition for rehearing and/or modification of Decision No. 90383 on June 21, 1979, amended July 18, 1979. By a resolution adopted August 23, 1979, SCRTD has withdrawn its petition.

Figueroa Hotel Company ("Hotel"), which made no appearance and did not otherwise participate in this matter, has filed a petition for rehearing of Decision No. 90393 and requested that the Commission permit it to participate in any further proceedings related to this application.

The Commission lacks authority to accept and consider the merits of a petition for rehearing filed by an entity not described in Section 1731 of the Public Utilities Code. Hotel's petition fails to allege any facts indicating that it is such an entity and accordingly is dismissed.

IT IS ORDERED that SCRTD's petition for rehearing and/or modification is dismissed at the petitioner's request.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Hotel's petition for rehearing is hereby dismissed.
