ORDER SETTING HEARING

By Decision No. 90802 in Case No. 5432, OSH 1019, et al., the Commission exempted from rates in Minimum Rate Tariff 2 the transportation of "Property, in interstate or foreign commerce, when transported in continuity with a prior or subsequent vessel movement." Companion orders were also issued in connection with the Commission's general commodity drayage tariffs - Minimum Rate Tariffs 1-B, 9-B, and 19.

That decision also concluded that Commission tariffs other than those already considered are applicable in similar circumstances. Therefore, it appears that hearings should be held in the captioned proceedings for the receipt of evidence concerning whether Minimum Rate Tariffs 3-A, 4-B, 6-B, 7-A, 8-A, 10, 11-A, 12-A, 13, 14-A, 15, 17-A, 18, and 20 should be modified in a manner similar to the modification of Minimum Rate Tariff 2 referred to above.

IT IS ORDERED that public hearings in this matter be held before such Commissioner or Administrative Law Judge as may be designated at a time and place to be determined.
