OPINION AND ORDER

By this application, Jose M. Gallegos, Frank Lee Richards III, and Henry Gallegos, a partnership doing business as R & G Transportation, requests authority to deviate from the provisions of Minimum Rate Tariff 2 in connection with transportation of plastic pipe and fittings from plant sites in Paramount and Woodland to various points in California for Carlon Products (Carlon).

Applicants state that they transport approximately eight truckload shipments per week weighing an average of 20,000 pounds per shipment for Carlon and that all shipments are power-loaded by Carlon and unloaded by consignee at point of destination. Applicants further state that even with this volume they cannot offer any reduction in rates under the provisions of Minimum Rate Tariff 2. As a result, applicants have proposed that a reduced classification rating be applied to the shipments for Carlon.

Revenue and expense data submitted by applicants indicate that the transportation involved may reasonably be expected to be profitable under the proposed rates.

The application was listed on the Commission's Daily Calendar of July 20, 1979. No objection to the granting of the application has been received.

In the circumstances, the Commission finds that applicants' proposal is reasonable. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that the application should be granted as

set forth in the ensuing order, and the effective date of this order should be the date hereof because there is an immediate need for this rate relief.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Jose M. Gallegos, Frank Lee Richards III, and Henry Gallegos, a partnership doing business as, R & G Transportation, are authorized to perform the transportation shown in Appendix A attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof at not less than the rates set forth therein.

2. The authority granted herein shall expire one year after the effective date of this order unless sooner cancelled, modified or extended by further order of the Commission.

The effective date of this order is the date hereof.

APPENDIX A

Carrier: Jose M. Gallegos, Frank Lee Richards III, and Henry Gallegos, a partnership doing business as R & G Transportation.

Commodities: Plastic Pipe or Tubing and Plastic Fittings, crated, packaged or bundled.

Reference Items 156600, 156994 and 156847 of Governing Classifications.

Shipper: Carlon Products, An Indian Head Company.

Territory: From: Paramount or Woodland, California
To: All Points within California

Ratings: Class 50 for Plastic Pipe and Class 55 for Plastic Fittings. Subject to a 21,000 pound minimum per unit of carrier's equipment utilized.

Conditions:

1. Shipments to be power loaded by consignor.
2. Shipments to be unloaded by consignee.
3. Shipments shall be released at 50 cents per pound per article.
4. Master Bills not to exceed three stops in transit to complete partial unloading.
5. Fittings not to exceed (15%) of total weight of shipment.
6. Applicants have not submitted costs for subhaulers. Therefore, if subhaulers are employed, they shall be paid not less than the rates authorized herein with no deduction for use of applicant's trailing equipment.
7. In all other respects, the rates and rules in Minimum Rate Tariff 2 shall apply.
