ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Escalon Water and Light Company (Escalon) on May 16, 1978, under Advice Letter No. 17, filed tariff sheets for extending service to an area not previously served. The area is contiguous to Escalon's presently certificated area. The city of Escalon advised that it too proposed to serve this area.

On June 27, 1978 the Commission suspended the effective date of said tariff sheets and ordered an investigation to determine whether said tariff sheets were reasonable or unlawful in any particular.

By letter dated August 7, 1979 Escalon advised that negotiations to sell to the city of Escalon are nearing completion and requested that Advice Letter No. 17 be canceled.

Good cause appearing, IT IS ORDERED that Case No. 10611 is discontinued.

The effective date of this order shall be thirty days after the date hereof.
