ORDER OF REVOCATION

Commission Decision Nos. 89413 and 89414, each dated September 19, 1978, granted certificates of public convenience and necessity to Pacific Western Stage Lines, Inc., authorizing the operation of sightseeing tours to The Burbank Studios and to Newport Beach from named points in Los Angeles and Orange Counties. Ordering Paragraph 2 of each decision required applicant to satisfy the "insurance requirements of the Commission's General Order No. 101-Series" and to establish the authorized service "within one hundred twenty days after the effective date of this order."

On June 29, 1979, the Commission staff sent a letter to Mr. John Gottlieb, applicant's president, advising that our

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agency had not yet received the certificate of insurance required for the service (Form PE-610). Applicant has not responded to the letter nor made an insurance filing.

It appears and the Commission finds that these matters constitute good cause for the revocation of the aforementioned certificates and that such revocation would not be adverse to the public interest. The Commission therefore, concludes that the certificate should be revoked and that tariffs and timetables applicable to the service thereunder should be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificates of public convenience and necessity to operate as a passenger stage corporation authorized by Decision Nos. 89413 and 89414 are hereby revoked, and all effective tariffs and timetables on file with the Commission in the name of Pacific Western Stage Lines, Inc. are canceled upon the effective date of this order.
