ORDER OF DISMISSAL

In his application Paul Schmalz requests that Buckingham Park Water System be given special authorization to make a water service connection to his property. Decision No. 88539 had declared a moratorium on such water service connections. Late in 1978 the Commission staff learned that he was receiving water from Buckingham Park County Water District, successor to Buckingham Park Water System. On March 12, 1979 the Commission's chief hydraulic engineer wrote to applicant requesting applicant to withdraw his application if applicant in fact was not receiving water. No response has been received to that letter. On July 30, 1979 the Administrative Law Judge assigned to the case wrote applicant that there appeared to be no need to proceed with the application if applicant was in fact receiving water service and that if no word was received from applicant by August 30, 1979 a dismissal of the application would be processed. No reply to the letter of July 30, 1979 has been received.
