OPINION AND ORDER

By this application, Western Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc., Agent (WMTB), seeks authority on behalf of Fix & Brain Vacuum Truck Service (FBV), to increase rates for tank truck vacuum and pump services.^{1/} WMTB proposes to cancel FBV's participation in Item 200 of its Local Vacuum and Pump Truck Tariff No. 7, Cal. P.U.C. No. 17 (WMTB 7) and add FBV's participation in Item 220 of the same tariff.

Applicant states that in FBV's opinion, the existing charges in Item 200 of WMTB 7 are insufficient to recover its costs and in order to more nearly meet expenses FBV desires to charge the higher rates in Item 220 of WMTB 7.

Applicant has been advised by FBV that the proposed increases would increase its yearly revenue by less than \$3,000, and that if the application is granted it would not increase FBV's gross revenue on intrastate traffic by as much as one percent. The amount of increase is within the President's wage-price guidelines.

The application was listed on the Commission's Daily Calendar of August 28, 1979. No objection to the granting of the application has been received.

^{1/} Fix & Brain Vacuum Truck Service is domiciled in Wilmington. The carrier provides transportation services in the counties of Kern, Los Angeles, Orange and Ventura.

In the circumstances, it appears, and the Commission finds, that increases resulting from the proposal herein are justified. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that the application should be granted.

IT IS ORDERED that:


1. Western Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc., Agent is hereby authorized, on behalf of Fix & Brain Vacuum Truck Service, to publish amendments to its Local Vacuum and Pump Truck Tariff No. 7, Cal. P.U.C. No. 17, as specifically proposed in the application.

2. Tariff publications authorized to be made as a result of the order herein shall be filed not earlier than the effective date of this order and may be made effective not earlier than five days after the effective date of this order on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public.


3. The authority herein granted shall expire unless exercised within ninety days after the effective date of this order.

This order shall become effective thirty days after the date hereof.




