ORDER EXTENDING TIME

By Decision No. 89549 in Application No. 58188, we authorized a transfer of certain passenger stage operating rights to C T & E Travel Corporation. Said transference was completed and the transferee accepted the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity as authorized by Decision 89549. However, tariff and timetable filings, as required by our order in that decision, were not made. Accordingly, the Commission staff contacted CT&E Travel Corporation and was advised that it would soon make the necessary filings and wished to inaugurate service with the start of the spring travel season. Contemporaneously, CT&E applied for additional passenger stage operating authority, which we granted by Decision No. 89891 on January 16, 1979 (Application 58402). It was thereafter expected that C T & E would make the requisite tariff, timetable, and insurance filings for all of its passenger stage routes, as extended by Decision 89891, and that these filings would be made prior to the summer travel season in 1979. These filings were not forthcoming, however, and, by letter dated August 2, 1979, the staff

requested the applicant to explain its intention regarding these passenger stage services, advising that it might be necessary to recommend revocation of these operating rights in the event of further unexplained delay in commencing these services.

By letter dated August 14, 1979, Ruth Mangolies, President C T & E Travel Corporation, stated applicant's intention to be fully operational no later than the summer travel season of 1980.

The Transportation Division recommends that an extension of time be granted to applicant, allowing until June 1, 1980 for compliance with the remaining requirements of Decisions 89549 and 89891.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that:

Applicant is granted an extension of time to June 1, 1980 to complete the tariff, timetable, and insurance filing requirements of Decisions 89549 and 89891, and until June 15, 1980, to commence the passenger stage services authorized therein.

The effective date of this order is thirty days from the date hereof.
