ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On September 12, 1979 the Commission issued Decision No. 90786 in this case. On September 20, 1979 complainant filed a petition requesting modification on the ground that there was a mathematical error in computing the award.

Complainant and defendant have now filed a request for dismissal with prejudice indicating that defendant has agreed to adjust complainant's yellow page advertising charges by \$533.20 and complainant's exchange charges in the amount of \$46.76 and that complainant has agreed to these adjustments.


We find that because of this request for dismissal no further action is necessary on complainant's petition for modification and conclude that this case should be dismissed with prejudice.

IT IS ORDERED that this complaint is dismissed with prejudice.

This order is issued pursuant to Section 308 of the Public Utilities Code and Resolution No. A-4638.
