ORDER OF DISMISSAL

In this application Juan David Carrillo seeks a Class "B" certificate to operate as a charter-party carrier of passengers. On May 16, 1979, a letter from James K. Gibson, Director, Transportation Division, was sent to applicant directing that a copy of the application be served on three carriers operating in the San Jose area; that proof of service be furnished to the Commission staff; and that applicant provide a telephone number at which he may be reached. On July 31, 1979, a follow-up letter was sent to applicant advising applicant that the application would be dismissed if he did not communicate with the Commission staff by August 31, 1979, relating to the contents of the May 16, 1979, letter. Applicant has failed to respond to either letters.

Based on the above facts, the Commission finds that the application should be dismissed for failure of applicant to prosecute.

IT IS ORDERED that Application No. 58728 is dismissed without prejudice.
