SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision 90462 Adams Delivery Service, Inc. (Adams) was granted authority to deviate from the provisions of Minimum Rate Tariff 2 in connection with the transportation of shipments of drugs and sundries, weighing 500 pounds or less, from Oakland to various destinations. Adams has informed the Commission that it is moving its terminal and principal place of business from Oakland to San Leandro.


Pursuant to Resolution A-4661,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Appendix A of Decision 90462 is amended by substituting "San Leandro" for "Oakland" in:
 - a) Paragraph 1 of "Application" (line 3)
 - b) Paragraph 2 of "Application" (line 2)
 - c) Paragraph 6 of "Rules" (line 2)
 - d) Paragraph 8 of "Rules" (line 2)
2. In all other respects, Decision 90462 shall remain in full force and effect.
