SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision No. 89010 the Commission granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to Stuart Alan Messnick, doing business as The-Co-Ordinators, authorizing him to operate as a passenger stage corporation to and from Los Angeles Rams football games at Anaheim Stadium from various points in Southern California. Ordering paragraph 3 provided that the certificate shall expire if the service is not established on or before August 1, 1979.

By letter dated September 10, 1979, applicant advised the Commission staff that the Rams have not yet determined their schedule for the upcoming football season. Applicant, consequently, cannot file tariffs or timetables in anticipation of the bus service and requests an extension of the expiration date for his establishing the service to 1980.

Because applicant cannot presently foresee the exact date the Rams will commence playing at Anaheim Stadium, the following order will grant an appropriate extension.

IT IS ORDERED that:

Ordering Paragraph 3 in Decision No. 89010 shall be amended as follows:

"This certificate shall expire if the service authorized by this order is not established on or before December 31, 1980."

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
