ORDER MODIFYING DECISION NO. 90370

The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company (Pacific), by D.90370 dated June 5, 1979, was ordered, among other things, to change the notation on its telephone directory exchange maps from "Portions in Adjacent Directory" to "Listings May Be In Either of Two Adjacent Directories". This change was intended to emphasize that should a subscriber be unable to find the number he is seeking in one directory, he should try the adjacent directory. In preparing to implement the ordering paragraph, Pacific noted that although the instant complaint involved only two directories, it was possible for a subscriber with a Los Angeles address to be listed in any one of six directories. Consequently, Pacific filed its petition to modify D.90370 by changing the notation required by Ordering Paragraph 1 from "Portions in Adjacent Directory" to "Listings May Be In Any of The Adjacent Directories".

Notice of this petition appeared in the Commission's Daily Calendar on October 10, 1979, and Pacific has served notice to the Estate of Jackie Clark, the complainant. No objections to the granting of the requested modification of the decision were received.

C.10672 SW The Commission finds that Pacific's request is reasonable. There is no known opposition and no reason to delay granting the request. IT IS ORDERED that: 1. Ordering Paragraph 1 of D.90370 is amended to read as follows: The notation appearing on defendant's telephone directory exchange maps shall be changed from "Portions in Adjacent Directory" to "Listings May Be In Any of The Adjacent Directories". In all other respects, D.90370 shall remain in full force and effect. The effective date of this order shall be thirty days after the date hereof.
