ORDER OF DISMISSAL

In this application, Walter Rice, Marjorie H. Nore, and Katherine W. Gibbs doing business as Incredible Journeys, originally applied for a Class B charter-party permit to carry passengers in Tuolumne County. Because of protests to the application, the applicants agreed to restrict the transportation to vehicles carrying no more than 14 passengers plus the driver.

The applicants already hold a charter-party permit (TCP-1215-P) under which they can operate 14-passenger vehicles. They have therefore requested dismissal of this application.

IT IS ORDERED that this application is dismissed.

The effective date of this order shall be thirty days after the date hereof.
