In the Matter of the Petition of ROESCH LINES, INC., a California corporation, for revocation of its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate passenger stage service.

Application No. 58843 (Filed April 30, 1979)

ORDER OF REVOCATION

Decision No. 90516, dated July 3, 1979, allowed Roesch Lines, Inc. to suspend passenger stage operations between Riverside and Hemet for a period of 90 days, during which time the company and CALTRANS were to negotiate the reestablishment of the service under subsidy. Ordering Paragraph 2 of Decision 90516 provided for revocation of the passenger stage certificate if service has not been resumed at the end of the 90 days.

On November 15, 1979, staff of the Commission's Transportation Division spoke with the secretary/treasurer of Roesch Lines and learned that the service had not been resumed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity for Roesch Lines, Inc. to operate as a passenger stage corporation, issued by Decision No. 81828, is hereby revoked. All effective tariffs and timetables on file with the Commission in the name of Roesch Lines, Inc., are canceled upon the effective date of this order.
