## OPINION AND ORDER

By this application Western Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc., Agent, seeks authority for and on behalf of Smith riansportation Co. (Smith) to amend Western Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc., Agent, Local, Joint and Proportional Freight and Express Tariff No. 111, Cal. P.U.C. No. 15, regaraing charges for exclusive use/full utilization of equipment.

Smith presently participates in an exclusive use of equipment (Item 289) and a full utilization of carrier's equipment rule (Item 395). Smith plans to cancel its participation in these two items and become a participant in an item whick covers both situations (Item 311). I

Applicant states that it is the purpose of this application to establish Swith's participation in a full utilization rule which will provide a more equttable level of charges by following more closely the cost of providing such service than the present provisions. The proposed pabiication will fill a definite and legitimate need of Spith. It will prevent an out-of-pocket loss when transporting high rolume, low density freight temdered in large quantities and requiring full use of one or more units of carriex's equipment. rhe commission

[^0]in Decision 63234, Gated February 6, 2972, stated: "When a carriex provides to a shipper full use of equipment or facilities, it has the right to just and reasonable compensation, therefore, regardless of whether those facilities are ordered or are necessitated by reason of the nature of the shipment. As a general proposition, corrier should be authorized to establish minimum charge for providing the facilities and service under those conditions."

Applicant has been acvised by Smith that granting of the proposal herein will increase its gross Califormia intrastate revenue by approximately $\$ 5,000$ annally. This amount would not increase Smith's California intrastate revenue by as much as one percent. The increase is within the President's wase-price guidedines.

The application was Iisted on the Comission's Daily Calencar of November 20, 2979. No objection to the granting of the application has been received.

In the circumstances, the Commission finds that the proposed changes are justified. A public hearins is not necessary. The Comission concludes that the application shoule be granted as set forth in the ensuing order, and the effective date of this order shonid be the date hereof because there is an inmediate need for this rate relief.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Western Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc., Agent, is hereby authorized, on behalf of Smith Iransportation Co., to publish in its Local, Joint and Proportional Freight and Express Tariff No. 111, Cal. P.U.C. NO. 25, the amendments as specifically set forth in its application and in Appendix $\lambda$ attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.
2. Tariff publications authorized to be made as a result of the order herein shall be filed not earlier than the effective date of this order and may be made effective not earlier than five days after the effective date of this order on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public.

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3. The authority granted herein shall expire andes exercised within ninety days after the effective date of this order.
