ORDER OF DISMISSAL

By Application No. 58539, Siskiyou Vangas requested authority to discontinue the operation of and abandon its liquid hydrocarbon gas system.

On March 20, 1979, Senate Bill No. 734, proposing to amend Section 221 of the Public Utilities Code, was introduced in the State Legislature and ultimately was signed into law, effective January 1, 1980. Senate Bill 734 amends Section 221 of the Public Utilities Code by exempting propane systems from the definition of gas plant and, therefore, removes all liquid hydrocarbon utilities from Commission jurisdiction.

By letter dated December 21, 1979, Siskiyou Vangas, through its attorney, filed a written request for dismissal of Application No. 58539 and gave notice that effective January 1, 1980 it would withdraw and cancel its tariffs in the form presently on file with the Commission.

IT IS ORDERED that Application No. 58539 be dismissed.

This order is issued pursuant to Section 308 of the Public Utilities Code and Resolution No. A-4638.

The effective date of this order shall be thirty days after the date hereof.
