ORDER OF DISMISSAL

In this application A. F. Neal, doing business as Flamingo Charter Service, originally applied for a Class "B" Charter-party certificate to carry passengers. Protests were received but were subsequently withdrawn due to the applicant's promise to use only vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 15 passengers. Since this restriction would give them no advantage over a regular Charter-party permit, applicant decided to withdraw his application for a Class "B" Charter-party certificate and apply for a regular Charter-party Carrier of Passengers permit.


The applicant applied for and was issued a regular Charter-party permit by this Commission on November 1, 1979. He has, therefore, requested dismissal of this application.

IT IS ORDERED that this application is dismissed.

This order is issued pursuant to Section 308 of the Public Utilities Code and Resolution No. A-4638.
