OPINION AND ORDER

By this petition, Werner Corporation, doing business as Foster Sand & Gravel Co., seeks modification of Section 3 of Minimum. Rate Tariff 17-A (MRT 17-A). MRT 17-A names minimum rates for the transportation of property in dump truck equipment from defined production areas to designated delivery zones and points in southern California. Section 3 of the tariff names specific delivery points for the application of Area-to-Point rates.

Petitioner is in the business of providing ready mixed concrete in Orange and Riverside Counties. In the continuance of its business petitioner seeks: 1) to discontinue a present plant which is named in Section 3 of MRT 17-A; 2) to add a plant under its firm's name which is presently operating under another name already published in Section 3 of MRT 17-A; and, 3) add a point to Section 3 of MRT 17-A which, to petitioner's knowledge, has been in operation since 1952 as a full service concrete plant, which was inadvertently omitted from the tariff during a previous change.

The above modifications are sought in order to be more competitive with other concrete mixing firms in the Orange and Riverside areas. If granted, the petitioner would be entitled to a rate reduction of 3¢ per ton from the applicable zone rates in MRT 17-A.

C. 9819, Pet. 41 - BW A staff field survey has determined that the petitioner's additional plants conform to the delivery point criteria established by Decision 57675, dated December 2, 1958 and Decision 80810, dated December 12, 1972 in Case 5437. Copies of the petition were served on various known carrier and shipper organizations and other parties on or about December 5, 1979. The petition was listed on the Commission's Daily Calendar of January 8, 1980. No objection to the granting of the petition has been received. In the circumstances, the Commission finds that the establishment of two new delivery points as hereinafter provided will result in just, reasonable and nondiscriminatory minimum rates for the transportation involved. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that the petition should be granted as indicated in the ensuing order. IT IS ORDERED that: Minimum Rate Tariff 17-A (Appendix C of Decision 80578, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein to become effective thirty-nine days after the date hereof, Sixth Revised Pages 3-3 and 3-4, Ninth Revised Page 3-5 and Tenth Revised Page 3-6, attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof. 2. Common carriers subject to the Public Utilities Act, to the extent that they are subject to Decision 80578, as amended, are authorized to establish in their tariffs the amendments necessary to conform with the further adjustments ordered herein. Tariff publications authorized to be made by common carriers as a result of this order may be made effective not earlier than thirty-nine days after the date hereof and may be made effective on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public

4. Common carriers in establishing and maintaining the amendments authorized by this order are hereby authorized to depart from the provisions of Section 461.5 of the Public Utilities Code to

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the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the amendments published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing long- and short-haul departures and to this order.

- 5. In all other respects Decision 80578, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.
- 6. The Executive Director shall serve a copy of this decision on every common carrier, or such carriers' authorized tariff publishing agents, performing transportation services subject to Minimum Rate Tariff 17-A.
- 7. The Executive Director shall serve a copy of each of the amendments on each subscriber to Minimum Rate Tariff 17-A.

The effective date of this order shall be thirty days after the date hereof.
