Supplemental Opinion and Order

By Resolution PE-349 (RRD 103), dated June 1, 1977 Greyhound Lines, Inc., was authorized to provide service between Sacramento and Stockton over Interstate 5 being identified as Certificate Route 10.08 and between Stockton and Interstate 580 over Interstate 5 being identified as Certificate Route 10.09.

Decision 88688 (Application 57775), dated April 4, 1978 authorized Greyhound to serve between Fairfield and Lodi. For reasons which seemed appropriate at the time, the construction of Interstate 5 not being completed between Secramento and Stockton, Certificate Routes 10.08 and 10.09 were cancelled and the authority for the service between Fairfield and Lodi was assigned as Certificate 10.08 and Certificate 10.09 was reported as being intentionally left blank.

The construction of Interstate 5 has now been completed and the prior authorities granted to Greyhound between Sacramento, Stockton and Interstate 580 should be reinstated. This supplemental order will reinstate those authorited with Sacramento-Stockton being identified as Certificate Route 10.09 and Stockton-Interstate 580 being identified as Certificate Route 10.09A.

Because Interstate 5 is now open for travel and this is a corrective order, the effective date should be the date hereof.

GREYHOUND LINES, INC. EIGHTH REVISED PAGE 23 CANCELS SEVENTH REVISED PAGE 23

10.06A - Between the junction of French Camp Road and Airport Way, and the junction at California Highway 120 and Airport Way:

> From the junction of French Camp Road and Airport Way, over Airport Way to the junction of California Highway 120, to be operated as an alternate route.

10.07 - Between Stockton and South French Camp Junction:

From Stockton over Interstate Highway 5 to South French Camp Junction, to be operated as an alternate route.

10.08 - Between Fairfield and Lodi, California.

From Fairfield, over California Highway 12 via Rio Vista to Lodi and return over the same route, serving all intermediate points.

This authority shall be of no further force and effect upon termination of the carrier's contract with the City of Rio Vista, California.

Restriction: No passengers will be transported to or from Travis Air Force Base or between points in Fairfield and Suisun City over the above route.

*10.09 - Between Sacramento and Stockton:

From Sacramento over Interstate 5 to Stockton, to be operated as an alternate route.

*10.09A - Between Stockton and the Junction of Interstate Highway 580:

From Stockton over Interstate Highway 5 to the junction of Interstate Highway 580, to be operated as an alternate route.

10.10 - Between North Manteca and South Manteca:

From North Manteca, over unnumbered highway to South Manteca, to be operated as an alternate route.

10.11 - Between North Lodi Junction and South Lodi Junction:

From North Lodi Junction, over unnumbered highway via East Lodi to South Lodi Junction.
