ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This application was filed on June 26, 1978, alleging the facts with respect to the passage of Proposition 13 on the June 1978 California ballot, and requesting Commission authorization to establish a tax reserve account to account for any reduced property taxes by reason of the Jarvis-Gann constitutional amendment.

The Commission instituted OII No. 19 on its own motion on June 27, 1978 directing all utilities under its jurisdiction to establish tax initiative accounts such as that proposed by San Diego Gas & Electric Company (SDG&E).

On August 15, 1978, SDG&E filed a motion to dismiss this application on the ground that OII No. 19 made the application moot. The motion should be granted.

IT IS ORDERED that the application is dismissed as moot.
