ORDER OF DISMISSAL

By this application, VTS Trucking seeks authorization to have published, for and on behalf of itself, increases on existing rates for the transportation of petroleum products, in bulk, in vacuum-type and pump-type tank trucks and tank trailers. The rates to be increased were those published for the account of McAuley Oil Company in the Western Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc., Agent, Local Vacuum and Pump Tariff No. 7, Cal. P.U.C. No. 17.

The Commission analysis disclosed the following:

- 1) McAuley Oil Company has been granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity as a Petroleum Irregular Route Carrier for the transportation of petroleum products, in bulk, in vacuum-type and pump-type tank trucks and tank trailers only. (D.86617, dated June 13, 1977 in A.56703).
- 2) VTS Trucking has no authority issued by this Commission.
- 3) No application has been received from either of the parties to transfer the authority.

Based upon the above facts, the staff recommends that the instant application should be dismissed without prejudice. ✓

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that Application No. 59405 is dismissed without prejudice.

The effective date of this order shall be thirty days after the date hereof.
