SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Decision No. 91561 dated April 15, 1980 was made effective on the first day of the month following the date of signature, or May 1, 1980 in this case. However, Ordering Paragraphs 1 and 2 authorized Southern California Edison Company (Edison) to file with this Commission revised schedules for water and electrical service as set forth in Appendix A of the decision on or after the effective date of the decision. The revised tariff schedules would become effective on not less that five days' notice to the public and the Commission. This would render the tariffs effective on May 5, 1980 at the earliest.

The intent of the Commission was to allow Edison to have its tariffs in effect on the first of the month following the date of Decision No. 91561. A correction of the effective date of that decision is necessary and should be made. The effective date of this order should be the date on which it is signed, since there is no known opposition and since the date on which any party may petition for rehearing remains unchanged.

IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 91561 is amended by making the effective date April 25, 1980.

This order is issued pursuant to Resolution No. A-4661, dated March 9, 1977, and is effective on the date hereof.
