SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision No. 90455, dated June 19, 1979, the City of Tustin was authorized to construct Dow Avenue at grade across The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company's tracks in the City of Tustin, Orange County.

In response to the railroad's letter of February 11, 1980, the City of Tustin, by its letter of February 25, 1980, has requested that the time limit contained in Finding 5 of Decision No. 90455 be extended for an additional six-month period. Said finding permitted the railroad to operate over the crossing with all movements protected by a member of the train crew for a period not to exceed six months from the date of the order.

IT IS ORDERED that Finding 5 of Decision No. 90455 shall be modified to change the period during which the railroad may operate over the crossing, with all movements over the crossing protected by a member of the train crew, from six months to one year from the date of the order (June 19, 1979).

In all other respects, Decision No. 90455 shall remain in full force and effect.
