ORDER RESCINDING DECISION

By Decision No. 91255 dated January 15, 1980, in Application No. 58759 Jerry Owens and Karen Owens, doing business as Our Bus was granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity, (PSC-1102) pursuant to Section 1031, et seq., of the Public Utilities Code (Code), to operate as a passenger stage corporation, as defined in Section 226 of the Code, to transport passengers on an "on-call" basis between an area surrounding Mission Viejo, as described in Appendix A of Decision 91255 and commonly known as Saddleback Valley, on the one hand, and the South Coast Plaza Shopping Center located in the City of Costa Mesa, the Fashion Island Shopping Mall located in the City of Newport Beach, and the Westminster Mall Shopping Center located in the City of Westminster, on the other hand.

By letter dated March 13, 1980, the carrier informed the Commission that due to certain conditions ^{1/} it wished to withdraw application for authority.

On March 25, 1980, staff of the Los Angeles Surface Passenger Operations Branch spoke with Karen Owens, co-partner of Our Bus who confirmed the desire of Our Bus to withdraw *the* application. SS

1/ "Due to the current economic conditions and the continually rising cost of gasoline, we feel we would be unable to provide the quality of service originally envisioned by our plan. We therefore, wish to withdraw our application for passenger service." ✓

It is observed by the staff that the carrier has not filed evidence of insurance as required by the Commission's General Order No. 101-Series in accordance with Ordering Paragraph 2(a) of the above decision.

Further, the carrier has not provided any public transportation under the authority granted due to non-compliance with rules outlined in Ordering Paragraph 2, Items (a) through (d).

It appears and the Commission finds that these matters constitute good cause for rescinding Decision 91255.

IT IS ORDERED that:

Decision 91255 is rescinded.






