OPINION AND ORDER

Decision No. 91152, dated December 18, 1979, granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to Warren Blodgett, doing business as Lake County Transit, authorizing ^{him} it to operate as a passenger stage corporation within the Counties of Lake and Mendocino. S

Among other things, the order provides:

"(b) Within one hundred twenty days after the effective date of this order, applicant shall establish the authorized service and file tariffs and timetables, in triplicate, in the Commission's office."

Applicant, by letter dated March 21, 1980, has requested a 90-day extension of time within which to begin the service authorized in Decision No. 91152 because of negotiations underway with Lake County regarding a county-wide transit system. Applicant is working closely with the county for assistance in funding the operation.

Findings of Fact

1. Decision No. 91152 authorizes Lake County Transit to begin operating as a passenger stage corporation providing service within the Counties of Lake and Mendocino.

2. Service is authorized to commence by April 16, 1980.

3. Applicant has requested a 90-day extension of time for filing of tariffs, timetables and commencing service due to pending negotiations with the county.

Conclusions

It is concluded that the requested 90-day extension of time be granted the applicant.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. A 90 day extension in time beyond that authorized in Decision No. 91152 dated December 18, 1979 be granted.

2. Ordering paragraph 2(b) of Decision No. 91152 is hereby amended as follows:

"(b) On or before July 15, 1980, applicant shall establish the authorized service and file tariffs and timetables, in triplicate in the Commission's office."

3. In all other respects, ~~the authority granted in~~ Decision No. 91152 ^{shall} remain ~~the same~~ ^{is} in full force and effect. The effective date of this order shall be the date
