ORDER EXTENDING TIME

Southern California Edison Company has petitioned by letter dated April 3, 1980, for an extension of two months on the deadline for filing a comprehensive report on the evaluation of Santa Catalina Island's water supply resources and potential system demands. Ordering Paragraph No. 4 of Decision No. 90265, dated May 8, 1979, in Application No. 58485 requires the report annually commencing April 1, 1980.

Southern California Edison Company requests the extra time to complete their evaluation of potential water system demands and to incorporate recently acquired information in the water supply resources report.

Findings of Fact

1. The requested extension of time is necessary for preparation of the directed report.
2. There is no reason for delay in authorizing the extension.
