ORDER OF DISMISSAL

The defendant Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) has advised the Commission in writing that complainants Raymond DeGennaro and Richard J. Clancy and defendant PG&E have settled this matter and are in agreement that the matter should be dismissed. By their settlement the parties agree that the \$2,943.85 on deposit with the Commission should be disbursed by returning \$1,200 to Security Pacific Real Estate, Inc. and by forwarding the balance of \$1,743.85 to PG&E in settlement of the deposited charge.

IT IS ORDERED that the complaint in the above-entitled matter is dismissed.


After the effective date of this order the sum of \$2,943.85, which was deposited by the complainants with the Commission in connection with this complaint, shall be disbursed by the Executive Director by remitting \$1,200 to Security Pacific Real Estate, Inc. and by forwarding the balance of \$1,743.85 to PG&E.
