OPINION AND ORDER

By this application Mc Auley Oil Company (Mc Auley) seeks to increase its rates for tank truck vacuum and pump services.^{1/} Mc Auley participates in Western Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc., Agent Local Vacuum and Pump Truck Tariff No. 7, Cal. P.U.C. No. 17 (WMTB 7). Mc Auley proposes, among other things, to participate in Item 220 of WMTB 7 and cancel its participation in Item 200 of said tariff. Item 220 provides higher rates than those published in Item 200. Mc Auley contends the existing charges are insufficient to recover its costs, and in order to more nearly meet expenses it desires to charge the higher published rates.

Applicant states that the proposed increases would increase its yearly revenue by less than \$1,000 and that if the application is granted it would not increase Mc Auley's gross revenue on intrastate traffic by as much as one percent. The amount of increase is within the President's wage-price guidelines.

^{1/} Mc Auley is domiciled in Long Beach and provides transportation services in the counties of Los Angeles, Orange, San Bernardino, Imperial and San Diego.

The application was listed on the Commission's Daily Calendar of March 25, 1980. No objection to the granting of the application has been received.

In the circumstances, the Commission finds that the proposed changes are justified. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that the application should be granted as set forth in the ensuing order, and the effective date of this order should be the date hereof because there is an immediate need for this rate relief.


IT IS ORDERED that:


1. Mc Auley Oil Company is hereby authorized to increase its rates and charges as specifically proposed in the application.
2. Tariff publications authorized to be made as result of the order herein shall be filed not earlier than the effective date of this order and may be made effective not earlier than five days after the effective date of this order on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public.
3. The authority herein granted shall expire unless exercised within ninety days after the effective date of this order.

The effective date of this order is the date hereof.
