ORDER OF REVOCATION

Commission Decision No. 90019 dated February 27, 1979,
granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to
Josefa Heyliger authorizing her to operate as a Passenger Stage
Corporation (PSC-1033), as defined in Section 226 of the Public
Utilities Code, to transport passengers and their baggage on an
on-call basis between Government Island in Alameda and San Francisco
International Airport.

The passenger stage operating authority of Josefa Heyliger
has been under suspension since July 11, 1979 for failure to have
evidence of liability insurance on file. Heyliger was notified that
~~her insurance had been cancelled by a notice of Impending Suspension~~
~~of Authority to Transport Passengers For Failure to Maintain on~~
~~Deposit Adequate Liability With The Commission dated June 15, 1979.~~
ABOUT THIS SUSPENSION BY LETTER

No reply was received.

On February 26, 1980, the Commission staff sent a letter to
Josefa Heyliger informing her that if no reply was received before
March 19, 1980, the staff would commence proceedings to permanently

revoke the passenger certificate. No reply has been received and no certificate of insurance has been filed.

It appears and the Commission finds that these matters constitute good cause for the revocation of the aforementioned certificate and that such revocation would not be adverse to the public interest. The Commission, therefore, concludes that the certificate should be revoked.

IT IS ORDERED that the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a Passenger Stage Corporation authorized by Decision 90019 is hereby revoked upon the effective date of this order.






