## ORDER RESCINDING DECISION NO. 91507

By Decision No. 91507, dated April 2, 1980, this Commission authorized Mission Trails Charter Service, Inc. to issue 50 shares of its capital stock to Richard L. Campbell (37-1/2 shares) and to Jacqueline Pung (12-1/2 shares), and authorized Richard L. Campbell to acquire control of the company. By letter dated May 12, 1980, the attorney for Mission Trails Charter Service, Inc. has informed the Commission's staff that the utility does not intend to exercise the authority granted to it to issue capital stock. This decision would also negate the transfer of control of the utility to Richard L. Campbell. Based on the attorney's letter, the parties request that Decision No. 91507 be rescinded.
