## SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision 91777, dated May 6, 1980, the Comission authorized transfer of a passenger stage certificate from Santa Monica Carousel Corporation to Santa Monica Flight Ifne, an equal partnership comprised of Onyx, Inc., a California corporation, and of William $H$. Martin, an indívidual.

Through inadvertence, Ordering Paragraph 4 makes reference to the issuance of a certificate of problic convenience and necessity to "Santa Monica Carousel Corporation, doing business as Santa Monica Flight Iine."

II IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Ordering Raragraph 4 of Decision 91777 is amended to read as follows:
4. In the event the transfer authorized in paragraph I is completed, effective concurrently with the effective date of the tariff filings required by paragraph 3, a certificate of public convenience and necessity is granted to Onyx, Inc., and William H. Martin, a partnership, doing business as Santa Monica Flight line, authorizing them to operate as a passenger stage corporation, as defined in Section 226 of the Public Utilities Code, between the points and over the routes set forth in Appendix A, attached hereto and made a part hereof.

In all other respects Decision 91777 shall remain in full force and effect. The effective date of this order is the date hereof. Dared_UN171080,
