ORDER EXTENDING STAY OF
DECISION NO. 91732

On May 15, 1980, a petition for rehearing of Decision No. 91732 was filed by Industrial Communications Systems, Inc., Intrastate Radio Telephone Inc. of San Bernardino, Intrastate Radio Telephone Inc. of Los Angeles, and Radio Relay Corp. - California. The filing of the petition on that date had the effect of automatically staying Decision No. 91732. (Public Utilities Code, Section 1733(a).) This stay expired by statute on July 14, 1980. (Public Utilities Code, Section 1733(b).) However, because the petition for rehearing is still under consideration, we are of the opinion that the stay should be continued pending the outcome of our review of the petition for rehearing.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 91732 is stayed until further order of the Commission.
