ORDER EXTENDING STAY  
OF DECISION NO. 91847

On June 23, 1980, a petition for rehearing of Decision No. 91847 was filed by Southern Pacific Transportation Company. The filing of the petition on that date had the effect of automatically staying Decision No. 91847. (Public Utilities Code, Section 1733(a).) This stay expires by statute on August 22, 1980. (Public Utilities Code, Section 1733(b).) However, because this petition and the separate petition for rehearing of Greyhound Lines, Inc., are still under consideration, we are of the opinion that the stay should be continued pending the outcome of our review of the petitions for rehearing.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 91847 is stayed until further order of the Commission.
